



FALL 2026 SEASONAL REMINDERS

Thank you for participating in WRSA's Fall 2026 season! We have a record number of teams this season – 455! As our league grows, we rely on our participants to help keep Stryker a safe and clean place for all.

- **PARKING** – All vehicles must be parked in a marked stall. Cars parked in the grass, in marked no parking areas (by sign or red curbs) or in handicap stalls with no placard/tag will be towed. There is plenty of parking in the stadium lot or in the ungated lot at 26th & Regency. Parking in the Receiving driveway is reserved for league/complex employees only!
- **CLEAN AS YOU GO!** – Please collect all trash from the bench areas and spectator sidelines after your game. Leave the field the way you would want to find it when you arrive! (This applies to teams that practice here as well.) We ask that food in our indoor facility be kept in the lobby area to help preserve the turf.

LEAGUE ITEMS:

- **GUEST PLAYERS** – U9 and older teams are allowed up to 3 guest players per game not to exceed roster maximum. There is no limit to the number of times a player may guest play for a team, but they may only guest play for ONE team per division. Please refer to the “Guest Player How To” on our website if you need help filling out the Guest Player Permit form.
 - Coaches must present a Guest Player Permit to the officiating crew at check-in. Digital copies will be accepted but must be emailed to wrsaoffice@strykersportscomplex.com by the Monday following the game.
 - Coaches must present the physical player card for the guest player at check-in. Digital or photocopies of the player card will not be accepted.
 - Players serving a red card suspension are not eligible to play as guest players until their suspension has been served.
 - Guest players are NOT allowed for U5 to U8 teams.
- **RESCHEDULES**
 - All reschedule requests must be submitted before 5PM on the Wednesday 10-days prior to the start of the league weekend either of the original game date or the requested game date (whichever is earlier). **Due dates are listed on the online reschedule form.**
 - Reschedules will not be processed until the Reschedule Request form has been received from **BOTH** teams. Reschedule request forms must be filled out by a team official from each team (i.e. one coach cannot fill out the form for both teams). Emails or phone calls to request reschedules will not be accepted.

- The \$50 reschedule fee is the responsibility of the initiating team and must be paid once the game has been rescheduled.
- **GAME CANCELLATIONS BY TEAMS** – Notification of any game cancellation or forfeit must be received by WRSA by NOON on Friday to avoid a \$50 forfeit fine. Early notification allows the league to reallocate our referee resources as necessary and provide ample notice to the opposing team. Teams that forfeit multiple games in a season will be subject to dismissal from the WRSA league.
- **LAWS OF THE GAME CHANGE**
 - **Law 15 – The Throw In:** Use of a 5-second visual countdown when a player/team is delaying the taking of a throw-in. If the time limit is exceeded, the throw-in is awarded to the opposing team.
 - **Law 16 – The Goal Kick:** Use of a 5-second visual countdown when a player/team is delaying the taking of a goal kick. If the time limit is exceeded, a corner kick is awarded to the opposing team.
- **GAME OFFICIALS** - Under NO circumstances should any team official or spectator approach a referee crew – before, during or after a game – or enter the referee room. If you have an issue that needs immediate response, please seek out a field marshal for help. They can be found on golf carts throughout the complex.

For non-immediate issues, coaches may fill out the Referee Feedback form on our website or email the office with any concerns. These emails will be forwarded to the Disciplinary Action Committee for further review. Please do not approach concessions staff with league concerns.

WRSA will be following the U.S. Soccer guidelines for referee abuse prevention:

- **RED CARDS** – Any team official or spectator that is issued a red card must exit the complex immediately. If you have a child playing, quickly arrange for your child to be brought to you off-site. Team officials or spectators that do not leave after a red card is issued risks further sanctions by the league up to and including expulsion from the league.
- **WEATHER** – WRSA monitors weather conditions and always strives to keep our players, staff and officials safe. Coaches will be notified of weather-related cancellations once those decisions have been made. Please do not call or email the office for this information.
